CHARLES DARWIN

Presentation by Dr. Howard Mooers

Dr. Howard D. Mooers is a professor in the Department of Geology within the Swenson College of Science and Engineering at the University of Minnesota Duluth. He has a doctorate from our satellite campus in the Twin Cities and has been a Fellow of the Geological Society of America since 1997.

He has presented numerous conference papers and published in journals such as Limnology and Oceanography, Quaternary Research, and the Canadian Journal of Earth Sciences. In the Water Resources minor, he investigates water as liquid (ground water), solid (glacial), and nearly vapor (acid rain).

He will speak to us about Charles Darwin on Sunday, February 2nd – just ten days ahead of Darwin Day.
